The GWRRA Colorado District will pay for the MFA (Medic First Aid) classes when you are enrolled in Rider Education Program. Here is the criteria that must be met:

The Member must be current Colorado GWRRA.

Only take the class to be current in the Rider Education Program. Must be at 2 year anniversary or renewal point.

If your GWRRA membership has expired, you will not show up on the Rider Education database. The new cost of the MFA is now \$25 as of 1 January 2012, due to rising cost of student materials.

Region F is proud to announce the New Red Heart Pin Program. When you complete a Medic First Aid CPR/FA class, you will be given an enameled Red Heart Pin for your vest. By wearing this pin, you are among an elite group of individuals who take pride in displaying their Rider Education levels and commitment to education.

After receipt of your class roster from your Facilitator, the pins will be mailed to them for distribution to you. If you have had a CPR/FA class within the last 2 years and would like a pin, you will be able to order one from the Winklers for \$4; your class participation will be confirmed. If you have used a different provider, a copy of your current card is required.
