I have new information for the MFA (Medic First Aid) classes. It has just been announced that Chapter I will pick up the cost of \$10 and the District will pick up the other \$10. The guidelines are the same just as the same as if the District did it last year. You must be enrolled in the Rider Education Program and must be up for renewal to take the MFA class. Keep in mind that I need 12 students. This is open to all Chapters. Please contact me to get registered. To gain access to the base, Security Forces will need your drivers licenses and your SSN to run a local background check. Even if you can gain access, please submit the information so that others can enter the base. (Security Forces won't run 3 or 4 people.) The class for the CPR/First-aid is schedule for January 11, 2014 at the Air Force Academy Outdoor Recreation Center (Community Center, Bldg. 5136). SAFETY NOTICE PERTAINING TO KURYAKYN HANDLEBAR RISER/SETBACKS FOR GL1800 – KURYAKYN PART NUMBER 7437 NHTSA CAMPAIGN NO: 13E-037

"Kuryakyn Holdings, LLC ("Kuryakyn") has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists with Kuryakyn Handlebar Risers/Setbacks for GL1800 (Kuryakyn part number 7437) These handlebar risers/setbacks, sold between April 3, 2013 and July 1, 2013, may have screws that fracture suddenly after installation. If the screws fracture, it could potentially cause the OEM handlebar to separate from the steering mount increasing the risk of a crash."

If you purchased a set of Kuryakyn Handlebar Risers/ Setbacks for GL1800 (part number 7437) between April 3, 2013 and July 1, 2013, please immediately discontinue use of this product.

Customers who purchased this item during the affected time period will receive a letter from Kuryakyn which will notify them of the corrective action to take to have the screws replaced. Please feel free to share this notice with all of your riding friends or motorcycle club as well.
