RIDER EDUCATION

"Rain, rain, go away...'



"A"-Game a must.

Is it going to rain today? Are you going to get wet? Did you get wet yesterday? How bad was it? It's going to rain today. Do you have any rain gear? Your going to get drenched...STOP, STOP, STOP!!! All these questions about the rain, getting wet and staying dry my work friends would ask me. Most people don't realize that riding any motorcycle is a water sport...your gonna get wet at some point in time.

Let's define rain. The dictionary states: moisture condensed from the atmosphere that falls visibly in separate drops. I would have put clouds somewhere in that definition, but I'm not a meteorologist. In my opinion, there are two types of rain, east and west coast. Let's talk about Colorado rain. (this may apply to some places on the west coast...I don't know.) In Colorado, the atmosphere is dry, the clouds gets dark gray and then the rain may fall. It may start out slow and then build to a down pour. It may rain hard for about 40 minutes to a hour, maybe longer or perhaps less. The rain may let up to a light to medium drizzle. The sun may even come out. If you are on your motorcycle, keep riding, you may not get wet.

RIDER EDUCATION

Now let's talk about the east coast, roughly from Kansas City, KS. to the Atlantic coast. Now, when it rains out east, clouds don't turn gray...they turn black. It gets so dark, you may see the moon. :) If you have not taken cover, you better. The skies will open up and it will pour rain, heavily, for hours. Raindrop are the size of a June bug. If you try to run from your house to your detached garage out east in some areas...better bring a change of clothes...you will be drenched. You can take off a t-shirt and wring out water. (It may not always rain as I have stated, but I would rather ride in a Colorado rain than an east coast rain.)

Now riding in the rain brings out a different set of riding problems. Less traction, low visibility and getting rained on. Not only do you have to ride safe for yourself, you still must watch out for others. You still have to play defense. Once again...You must bring your "A"-GAME. Riding in the rain is a skill that I believe must be practiced as well. Whether riding alone or with your spouse, both must be on the same page when riding in the rain. Both need to know that it may be a long day and you might get wet. Laura and I rode from Wing Ding, Greenville, SC. to Mt. Vernon, IL. a couple of years ago. It rained off and on all day. It was dark, cool and wet. Remember: Any one can ride when it is sunny, warm and dry. But it takes a special skill set to ride when it is dark, cool and wet.
