RIDER EDUCATION

Winter Ride Time Limited

Some people state that they ride all the time in the winter...no, that they ride some of the time in the winter. Let's face it folks, Colorado is a snow state. Our skills are the sharpest during the summer months. We may ride during the winter, but our skills may not be as sharp as they were in the summer. For example, we wear different clothes, boots or gloves during the winter. If wearing summer gloves for most of the time and then changing to a thick winter glove, the feel of the handlebar will be different. You can still ride, but it is a different feel than with the summer glove. The throttle is different; the clutch has a different feel than the summer glove. The same will go for the boots and anything else that you may change. Just keep in mind that winter riding is different than summer riding.

We ride all the time in the summer, but some of the time in the winter.
