# MAY IS MOTORCYCLE AWARENESS MONTH

May marks the start of Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month when drivers of all other vehicles and all road users are reminded to safely "share the road" with motorcyclists, and to be extra alert to help keep motorcyclists safe.

On the other hand, it is imperative for all motorcycle riders to "gear up" and operate your bike with risk management being a priority. It is also important to be alert at intersections. A majority of motorcycle accidents occur at intersections because of a vehicle turning left in front of a motorcycle. This is because drivers of cars, SUV's and trucks simply are not looking for motorcycles they are looking for other vehicles. Even though the light is green for you, make sure no one is turning left in front of you. Ensure you are not hiding behind other vehicles. Remember, be smart and be safe at intersections.


And this is how they turned out!
