# **R. U. N . the GAME** (part 1) The Motorcycle

I'm going to talk about something we already know, but put a twist on it. Now that the snow is on the ground and most motorcycles have found their way to some shelter, now is the time to evaluate your motorcycle's health. <u>T-CLOCS</u>.

#### Are you in the game ... or just on the field?

Is your motorcycle in the game? Is it capable of doing what you want it to do or take you where you want to go? Yes, it is a Honda Goldwing, the most reliable motorcycle on the surface of the **Earth**, but the motorcycle still needs maintenance. That's where you come in to help your motorcycle. Give it the TLC (tender loving care) it deserves.

Take the time this winter to give your motorcycle the twice over and look for needed parts. Do a T-CLOCS on your motorcycle. Be ready to do the maintenance come May. Buy your parts and have them ready to put on in the Spring. How old is your battery? Can you see clearly through your windshield? When was the last time that you cleaned your air filter, just to name a few items. Also, if you have a trike, side car or trailer, you should do a T-CLOCS on those motorcycle items as well. We have all heard this information before and this is nothing new. You expect your motorcycle to work when you need it, but you cannot expect that motorcycle to work if you don't take care of it. Do your part. Maintain your motorcycle.

Here are the guidelines for taking the Medic First Aid/ CPR Classes to receive the special \$10.00 fee.

- 1. Your membership must be current and assigned to a Colorado Chapter
- 2. Members must be enrolled in the Levels Program

- If Level I, show your intention to be level three within a short period.

- 3. Your current Medic First Aid/CPR expiration should be within 90 days, or already expired
  - Remember that Level II requires an ERC course for the rider or Co-Rider Seminar for the co-rider. Level III Requires Medic First Aid/CPR.
  - If you have any questions about where you are in the Levels program, please feel free to call or ask your Chapter Educator
