The Rider

The Rider...the one that puts it all together, responsible for the maintenance and the CO-Rider. The Rider sets the example of how to dress for the ride, wearing all of the gear and ensuring the CO-Rider does the same. Responsible for the maintenance and safety of the motorcycle. Rider needs to be sharp in his or her riding skills to ensure a safe journey. By doing everything in part one and part two (Maintenance and CO-Rider, January & February 2016 issues), you ensure that your motorcycle and the CO-Rider will be safe to the best of your ability. Now, as the Rider, you need to be in the game. You need to take an Experienced Rider Course (ERC) to enhance your riding skills. You should get the dust off of your skills after a long winter. Now some people need to go to a parking lot and practice, and some just need to ride for about five minutes or so to get their muscle memory back. Remember...everybody is different in how they get ready for the game. Just make sure that your motorcycle, CO-Rider and Rider are ready to be in the game.
