RIDER EDUCATION

IT'S RIDING SEASON-- ARE YOU & YOUR BIKE READY TO RIDE?

Maintenance Day is usually filled with tire changes, oil changes, fork seals, and other general maintenance of the bike.

Having just had our Annual Chapter Maintenance Day Gathering, thought it would be good to touch on some other things to consider in preparation for what's considered the 'primary' riding seasons.

What's the condition of your tires; how much tread is left, and how old are they? What shape is your windshield in? Have you done your T-Clocs of the bike? [For those who aren't familiar with the acronym; T-Clocs is for Tires & Wheels, Controls, Lights, Oil, Chassis, Sidestand.] This is the same for Trikes, except for the Sidestand.

How about your gear? 'What's the condition of your gloves, boots, jacket, pants, zippers, rain gear? How old is that helmet? What's the condition of your face shield?

Don't forget to check your trailer to be sure it's ready to go too! Lights, tire condition & pressures, and lubing the bearings.

Also, When's the last time you took a look at your First Aid kit? Does it need replenishing or replacing?

Don't forgot to be sure you've got your current copy of the Gold Book in your bike too!

Take the time to check things out now and get things handled so you're ready to ride!
