RIDER EDUCATION

Change is underway -

Rider Education is a vital part of GWRRA. The primary responsibility for the Rider Education Program will happen at the District level.

At the Chapter level, the position still falls under Rider Education, but is changing to that of Chapter Ride Coordinator.

The focus with the position of Chapter Ride Coordinator will be to coordinate rides; planning a variety of rides to suit Chapter Participants. Safety will be encouraged and communicated, sharing GWRRA's benefits of safety as developed through the Rider Education Program. The Rider Meeting will still be a part of getting ready for the ride to encourage safety practices, i.e. T-Clocs, group riding techniques; safety clothes, compliance with State law.

We don't know who the new Chapter Ride Coordinator is going to be yet, but wanted to give a little 'heads up' of the change.

Again, the focus will be more on the opportunities to ride and share the passion for the ride.

The Rider Levels program is still going to be in effect.
